2010 Victory Invitational Guidelines

Format:

This is a Varsity lineup event and an eight team invitational only tournament. There will be 18 individual weight classes. Each team is allowed one athlete per weight class, from their team roster. To complete their team, each team is allowed a maximum of five non team roster athletes. Athletes will then compete in their respective weight classes. Wrestlers will be placed in 2 pools based on seeding information received by each team. They first will wrestle 3 round robin pool matches. That will serve as qualifiers for championship or consolation brackets. These brackets will be a four man format. The top two from each pool advancing to championship bracket and the bottom two into consolation bracket. The winner of pool A and the runner up of pool B on the same side of bracket and the winner of pool B and the runner up of pool A on the same side of the bracket. The bottom two advancing to a consolation bracket 3rd from pool A and 4th from pool B on the same side and 3rd from pool B and 4th from pool A on same side. These brackets will wrestle to their completion except for championship matches. All championship athletes will compete in front of the fans on one mat, one at a time.

Weigh ins:

Begin at 7:30 by club (i.e. teams must weigh as a team if one athlete of team is not there when team is called that team will be skipped and next team will be called). At 8 a.m. last call will be given and teams will be weighed. If there are athletes still missing, those athletes will be scratched from event. There will be a scale challenge. Athletes will have the option of using all scales at the weigh-ins. Weigh-ins will be supervised by officials.

Wrestling:

Pool play will start at 9a.m. with a 5 minute break between each round.

Bracket matches will start at 12p.m. through to the completion of consolation bracket and third place matches on the championship bracket side.

Finals matches will begin at 2:30p.m. through the completion of all awards.

Awards:

*2nd - 4th in each individual bracket will receive t-shirts.

*Champion in each bracket will receive hooded sweatshirt. *Outstanding wrestler of event will receive a Port Authority soft shell jacket (this award will be determined by a majority vote of the 8 head coaches at the event, from the 18 individual champions of the event, in case of a tie the head official will cast the deciding vote).

*Team awards will be presented with trophies to the top three teams. Team points will be as follows:

10pts for 1st

7pts for 2nd

5pts for 3rd

3pts for 4th

1pt for 5th (the champion of the consolation bracket).

Bracketing:

Will be done based on registration entries with seeding information, with a brief seeding meeting with designated coaches from each team to review seeds at 8 a.m. the day of event . We will seed 1st thru 4th, with 1st and 4th seed going into pool A and 2nd and 3rd seed going into pool B. The remaining four will be drawn in via playing cards into their respective pools. It will be very important for coaches to have current information of their athletes listed per athlete per weight (i.e. accomplishments, records, and head to head results). Each team will receive a roster from the other teams attending event to review and comment on head to head results. If no info exists, the tournament committee will decide and that will be final. As with all other disputes, if no information exist all tournament committee seeds will be final.

Matches:

All Matches will consist of 3-1 ½ minute periods with NHSA overtimes to follow as needed. All matches will be conducted on 32' NHSA certified mats. We will use modified NHSA rules per our organization.

Protest policies:

An upfront \$100 protest fee will be collected at the time a satisfactory decision by the head referee cannot be attained leaving the tournament Director to make a decision. All tournament Director decisions are final and non-reversible.

Registration

Team registration is due by February 4th at 6pm.

Rosters will be due by February 10th at 6pm. Rosters must be accompanied by the event waiver and release to be signed by each athletes parent or legal guardian. Non team roster athletes need to be highlighted with a maximum of 5 non team roster athletes allowed per team.
